OUTDOOR SAFETY CHECKLIST



FOLLOW THE BELOW STEPS TO STAY SAFE USING ELECTRICALS OUTSIDE



Use only extension leads, cables, and connectors **suitable for outdoor use**.



Store tools **out of children's reach** and keep electrical equipment dry.



Before using an extension lead or cable reel, check they are **free from damage**, and always uncoil cable reels to prevent overheating.



Use a **residual current device (RCD)** with all outdoor electrical equipment.



Extension leads and cable reels should be **weather-resistant and rated correctly** to suit the equipment you want to connect to them.



Check for any damage before you use, like worn or frayed cables, broken parts or signs equipment has got wet.



Switch off and unplug electrical tools before cleaning, adjusting, or checking them.



Wear **gloves, goggles, and shoes** which protect your feet.



Ensure the **correct chargers** are used for rechargeable equipment and batteries, and only purchase **replacement batteries** from the original manufacturer.
